Dear Owen,

I confirm that a septic tank does not require Department of Local Government, Planning, Sport & recreation approval.

The provisions of the Plumbing & Drainage Act 2002 require that a person must not build, install or operate a septic tank that does not conform with AS/NZS 1546.

A local government may request documentation that demonstrates the septic conform with AS/NZS 1546. As you have a licence then there should be no problems.
